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DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty, is a form issued by the Department of Defense (DoD) and provided to every veteran discharged, retired, or separated from active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States. The form - sometimes incorrectly referred to as the DA Form 214 - was last revised on February 1, 2022 . A sample copy is available for download below. The form first appeared in 1950 as a replacement for the old WD AGO Forms and NAVPERS documents. The early version of the form was called the Report of Separation from Active Duty. The present name was given on July 1, 1979, and remained unchanged since. The DD 214 contains all the information necessary to verify an individual's military career. The provided information includes the following: The date and place of entry into active duty and discharge; Home address at the time of entry and after separation; Military education and job specialty; Acquired awards and decorations; Rank, rate or grade; Last duty assignment; Separation information, etc. A part of the retirement preparation process is completing a DD Form 214 worksheet. This document is sent to the retiree, who has to complete and thoroughly check the form before submitting it to the person in charge. The document will not be given to the soldier until the actual separation date. A finalized DD Form 214 will be available on the day of discharge. The DD Form 214 is necessary for obtaining VA benefits, applying for new jobs, getting subsidized loans, enrolling in Veterans organizations, etc. The certificate is given out to each soldier on the day of discharge. A DD Form 215 can be used to correct any mistakes found on the certificate. The process of replacing a lost or stolen certificate by the veteran, authorized representative, or next-of-kin takes three to four weeks. The simplest to request a copy of any of your military records is to visit the National Archives Website and file an online application. Standard Form 180, Request Pertaining to Military Records, is used to facilitate the process both when filing digitally and sending requests by mail. If you experience any difficulties with obtaining the DD Form 214 by yourself, you can always hire a third-party representative that will assist you with filing the required paperwork. To speed up the acquisition process and avoid any unnecessary delays make sure that all the required information is provided in full and all forms are signed and dated properly. Your application will be reviewed over the course of ten workdays. If requesting older records and forms that may have been lost to the 1973 fire at NPRC, be prepared to wait 6 months or longer. What Are DD Form 214 Discharge Codes? The DD 214 Form contains codes used by the DoD in order to denote the military retiree reenlistment eligibility and the reasons to discharge. These codes are called the SPN or discharge codes. The DoD prohibits the release of the meaning of the codes to the general public. There are many different interpretations online, but none of them are proven to be accurate or definite. Use the information available online at your own risk. It helps identify potential hazards before they become an issue, minimizing accidents and injuries that could occur during military operations and training exercises. When you apply for reenlistment, you may be asked to fill out a DD Form 368. You may also be asked to fill out a waiver. This form is used to request a conditional release from the Army Reserve. A DD Form 368 is an official application that is approved by the Army's commander and provides the applicant with the required time to complete his or her contract. To be eligible for the waiver of compensation, you must be a combat-wounded veteran. It is also important to note that you must meet the physical qualification requirements for general military service. The DD Form 368 has a section that includes your unit's commander. You must also provide your authorized representative's name, address, and phone number. Among other things, you must be in good standing with your unit's command and the Department of Defense. If your unit is undermanned, it may disapprove your request for conditional release. As you fill out the DD Form 368, you should remember to include any enlisted service from another service. For example, if you are a member of the Air Force or the Marine Corps, you should be sure to have a positive recommendation from your unit commander. Once you have filled out the DD Form 368, you will need to submit the application to your unit's commanding officer. This process may take weeks or months, depending on the level of command. Where Can I Find a DD Form 368? If you are interested in becoming a member of the Army Reserve, you should know that there is a form known as DD Form 368. This form is used to obtain a conditional release from the Reserves. The process takes months, and there are a few important steps to follow. First, you need to submit a letter from your unit's commander approving you for enlistment. You will also need to get a Letter of Release. You can get a copy of this document by going to the Chief of Naval Personnel's office in St. Louis, Missouri. They can be reached at 9700 Page Boulevard. After you have secured your letter, you need to submit a DD Form 368 to your commander. You can also find this form online. It will take you about 30 days to get your packet approved. You will need to provide your name, social security number, and address. In addition, you need to submit DD Form 214 and DD Form 215 with your application. These documents will be used to verify your past military service. In addition to obtaining a DD Form 214 and DD Form 215, you will need to get a waiver. A waiver of compensation is a request that you will not receive further compensation from the U.S. Army or the Department of Veterans Affairs. DD Form 368 - Request for Conditional Release When a member of the Army Reserve or National Guard is discharged, he/she may request a conditional release. Obtaining a waiver requires an endorsement by a commissioned officer. An applicant must also have his/her social security number. The DD Form 368 is a form that is used to apply for a conditional release. It includes the entire military record of the applicant. It is completed by both the recruiter and the applicant. This can take months to complete. Applicants should be careful to read all instructions carefully. A rejection of the packet can result in staying in the Reserves for an extended period of time. Once the DD Form 4 is signed, the service member will be released from the unit. However, if the unit is undermanned, they might disapprove of the conditional release. If the application for conditional release has been approved, the service member will remain in his/her current unit. During this time, the application will be processed by the approving authority. For example, the Commander of, U.S. Army Human Resources Command (USAHRC) can be contacted at 1600 Spearhead Division Avenue, Fort Knox, Kentucky. Enlisted personnel from the Army or Air Force must obtain approval from their unit commander to have their military service terminated. If the person is not a combat-wounded veteran, the unit must be able to confirm that he/she meets all enlistment requirements.
