Often preceded by an exposition. Usually, a string is given at the beginning of the work, and then the storyline begins to rise, but not always. The plot can be a sudden, unexpected, unmotivated, revealing work without any exposure. In a plot, the rising action is the road to the climax. It's all the stuff that sets the stage for biggest, most exciting moment in the book. Any work of art has an intricate thread, and the writer unleashes from chapter to chapter. That is why one of the main and obligatory elements of the plot is a rising action (remember, for example, the exposition is not at all obligatory). Rising action in the literature is the main event, which entails all subsequent actions. It defines the same thing that will occur in the book, representing the author's intention. It can be present in the form of one episode, and can be stretched into several scenes. Rising Action Definition Rising action is the key moment of any artwork, because it is the starting point of everything, what further will be discussed. Among the details in the story are mandatory and optional. The latter includes the exposition, which is not found in all stories and stories. Rising action is an indispensable element. It is impossible to exclude it from the plot. It should not be thought that a rising action is always an exceptional event, which turns everything upside down. On the contrary, it can be a banal scene of the arrival of one hero, some random conversation on the train, an involuntary meeting in the store or something similar. In a nutshell, it can be any action that we do day after day, without giving it any importance. However, here is a special charm: to start with something which would not be something important and valuable. By the way, such a rising action can be called implicit. There is still no conflict, but the life of the characters is changing a little, there is a push for thoughts or feelings, or both together. The obvious rising action is a loud argument, some kind of brawl, death, and everything that immediately deprives the familiar balance, opening up new spheres of reflection. Such rising action will be sudden, stormy, emotional. Most often, it does not presuppose the presence of an exposition and immediately introduces the reader to the course of the matter. Examples in literature If we recall that any work is based on conflict, then we can safely say that the outset is the origin of the conflict or its sudden detection. For example, at the beginning of one of Shakespeare's greatest tragedies, Prince Hamlet meets a ghost who told him a terrible secret. It was at this point that the prince's heart was poisoned by the thirst for revenge, which led him from action to action throughout the play. In Ender's Game, for example, Ender's training and everything that it involves is the rising action. It all leads up to Ender's final Command School test. In Hamlet is the meeting of the hero of the tragedy with the shadow and the subsequent decision of Hamlet to take revenge on the king for killing his father.
