In 1954, the Alliance Manufacturing Company first produced its own garage door opener unit. Named Genie, it was the first mass-produced, radio-controlled residential garage door opener, and became the market leader in the design, safety and reliable service - core values that Genie still upholds to this day. In 1958, Genie engineers brought about the innovation of the first direct-drive screw opener. Further design refinements resulted in the offering of a split rail, which opened opportunities to mass retailers for the first time in the mid-1970s. Consumer appeal for Genie products grew alongside the rapidly developing do-it-yourself market. In 1983, the company entered the home and shop vacuum market, and in 1985, it changed its name to Genie Home Products. By the time Overhead Door Corporation purchased the company in 1994, the Genie name had become a symbol of trust and reliability for millions of customers around the world who sought out the brand from professional dealers, home centers, hardware stores, and wholesale clubs.
