In these worksheets, students classify sentences as present perfect, past perfect or future perfect.The present perfect tense is the past participle tense used with the present tense of an auxiliary verb to have. In part 1 of this worksheet, students circle the present perfect verb tense in sentences. In part 2, they fill in the blank with the present perfect form of the verb in parentheses. We make the present perfect tense form by putting has or have before the past participle form of the verb. I have seen him before.They have arrived.He has stopped talking to me. Use has when the subject is a singular noun or pronoun. Use have when the subject is a plural noun or pronoun. Use have when the subject is the pronoun I or you. The past participle is the third form of the verb (v3). Most verbs have their past participle form ending in ed. Such verbs are called regular verbs. Some verbs are irregular.
