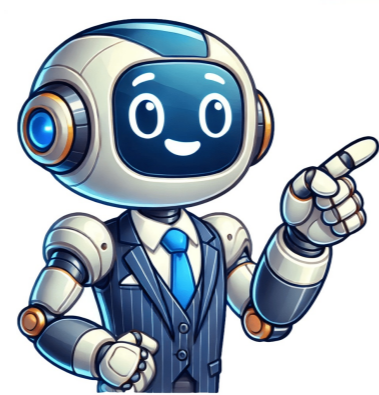

Some of the scenes feel awkward and out of place compared to whats happening in the Soul Kings palace, disrupting the overall flow and pacing.And seriously, why are Ichigos human friends even here? They contribute nothing to the story and have no bearing on the actual plot.
