Quick, easy and secure. As a parent, family member or carer, you may be able to access services for someone else. We call this having proxy access. You will need to request this access directly from the practice they are registered at. To request proxy access: collect a proxy access form from reception between 10am & 6pm Once proxy access is set up, you can access the other person's profile in your NHS or patient access account, using the NHS/ patient access App or website. The NHS website has information about using linked profiles to access services for someone else. eConsult is a confidential, digital triage and online consultation platform that allows the practice to deal with medical queries, eConsult will allow you to submit your symptoms or requests to the practice electronically for it to be then put to a triage team for them to offer you the most relevant clinician for your issue. eConsult avoids the need to potentially wait on the phone in a queue. The more information you are able to provide will help us to offer the most appropriate response or appointment. Our eConsult service is open from 7:45am to 18:30pm Monday to Friday, except for an afternoon closure on the 4th Wednesday of every month (subject to change) where we close for Training. Between the times of 7:45am and 10:00am we will only be triaging requests for same day appointments. All submitted eConsults are triaged by a GP and will be responded to promptly. The GP triaging or responding to your eConsult will determine the timeframe in which you need to be seen. We aim to respond by close of play that working day for urgent matters. However, routine matters will receive a response within 3 working days. If you feel the condition has worsened, please contact the practice, NHS 111 or 999 as appropriate.
