What is b2 english test

The Trinity B2 - ISE II is a comprehensive English language proficiency test that evaluates reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. It is typically taken at an approved Trinity SELT centre over one full day. The test measures an individual's level of English language ability, which is essential for certain visa applications, such as the Minister of Religion, Innovator, Start-up, Student, Book your B2 (ISE II) visas. The test assesses a person's ability to understand complex conversations and texts, communicate with native speakers, produce clear writing, and express personal opinions.
