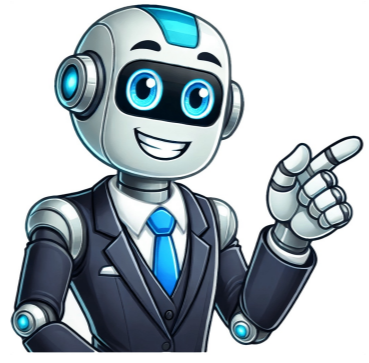

Mirage OS is a Flash Shell that enables various games to be run on your calculator, with this being the recommended shell for the TI-83+. This level pack for Mario 2.0 on the TI-83+ includes over 30 levels spread across 8 different worlds, based on the Super Mario Land levels of the Gameboy. Download the Super Mario Land Level Pack. The mega-hit Super Smash Bros. by Nintendo has been cloned and created for the TI-83+ and TI-84+ calculators. Don't miss this fantastic port of the classic game. Now, Fruit Ninja is available on your calculator, featuring an innovative control scheme to play and impress friends with ninja skills. Gemini is a great 3D shooter available for the TI-83 and TI-83+, but it requires most of your memory to run. Uncle Worm is a game similar to Nibbles, allowing your worm to travel in any direction, ideal for short periods of time. Advanced Racer is one of the best driving games on calculators, combining classic Gameboy driving style with relatively vivid graphics. This is recommended if you have spare memory. Phoenix 4 features score counting during gameplay, side-scrolling (with the option to turn this off), and bug fixes, making it the best Phoenix update yet. Ion is one of the simplest shells available, with a simple list view but capable of running most games flawlessly. This is my top choice for a shell on the TI-83. The classic game Connect 4 has been adapted for your calculator! In this version, you can change the rules to Connect 3, Connect 4, or Connect 5. You can also play by dropping pieces or in Tic-Tac-Toe mode. Desolate is a four-level, flickerless, grayscale RPG with a complex storyline and various enemies to collect. It's a must-download for any RPG fan. PlainJump is a platformer that requires precision jumping on 3D platforms; if you fall, you lose. The PuzzPack collection includes the best puzzle games on the TI-83+ and TI-84+, while Tic Tac Toe features an AI and has a minor bug with Mirage OS. Slimeball is a volley-ball-style game where you control a slime to defeat opponents, and AceJogyobis offers pinball gameplay. Asteroids is a classic game with an enhanced mode of play, including ship upgrades. Falldown is an arcade game where your goal is to prevent the ball from touching the top screen. Castlevania: Prelude to Chaos features platforming and items in four mansions against Dracula. The Verdante Forest is an excellent RPG with stunning graphics and a great story, while Maze 3D offers a challenging maze experience. Wizards is a Magic: The Gathering clone with nice graphics, but slightly different gameplay. Joltima is a fun RPG similar to Ultima Exodus and Dragon Warrior, despite less impressive graphics. Egypt is a multi-level puzzle game where you clear items from the screen. Solytare brings Solitare to your TI-83+ with surprisingly simple controls and graphics, containing 100 challenging levels. Lotus Turbo Challenge takes racing to new heights on the calculator with its simulated 3D view and simple controls. Phoenix is one of the top-rated shooters, while Crates 3D offers excellent graphics and gameplay. The game also warns about screen slant issues on some newer calculators. Phoenix Level Set - Renegade Diamonds features a classic breakout game, while Chu Chu Rocket boasts over 2600 levels with great graphics. Jupiter is a levelset for Phoenix, requiring Phoenix 2.0 or greater. Download Phoenix Level Set - Jupiter and Future Phoenix for an altered version of Phoenix 3.3 with new ships and weapons. PaRappa The Rapper requires reflexes to complete moves without messing up. Dying Eyes is a non-linear RPG with multiple endings. Firetrack features two modes of gameplay, including vertical scrolling shooter with detailed backgrounds and enemies. ZMercury offers side-scrolling action, while Anarchy is a space trading game. To start playing games on your TI-84 Plus CE, download the necessary software, such as TI Connect CE, and select popular platforms like CalcFlex.com or TIB4CalcWiz.com for game downloads. You will need to extract certain files if they are in a zip format, then send them to your calculator using TI Connect CE. Ensure that your calculator is connected to your computer via the charging cable and that it is turned on before sending the game files.
