Ipod touch 4th generation jailbreak

Before getting into details, let's talk a bit about how all this become a thing: In 2013, an iPhone hacker called "winocm", released a set of tools called "ios-kexec-utils". To avoid super-technical informations, let's just say a tool included in this project, kloader, is really useful to achieve multi-booting on iOS. For a lot of time, back in the days, almost no one got interest in it (mainly because people didn't know how to use it), but recently, thanks to Coolbooter and @nyan_satan, finally it become "popular" and manually dual-booting become something easier for people to do. Dual-booting offers not only the possibility to get a fully working 2nd os in your device, but also debugging boot-args, booting diags, switchboards and, in our case: booting firmwares from other devices. Now, in the case of the iPod Touch 4g, where there is a public bootrom exploit available, we could've already done it without dualbooting, but it would've been a lot harder to do. So, since the iPhone 4 got iOS 7 and its hardware is really similar to the iPod Touch 4g one, why not trying something? I was wondering how I could upgrade my jailbroken iPod touch 4g (4.1) to 5.1 or higher? I found the following instructions by cksun on the forum: You will require iTunes. Connect the device, then right click on it in the iTunes side bar. Select "Back Up." Allow it to runs its course. Close iTunes. Then put the device into DFU mode: 1) Power off the device. 2) Disconnect it. 3) Hold the power button for 2 secs. 4) Without letting go of the power button, press and hold the home button for 10 secs. 5) Let go of the power button but not the home button for another 10 secs. Reconnect the device and launch iTunes. It will detect your iPad and inform you it is in recovery mode. From there, it will check for the newest available update (5.1), download it and install it. When that completes, simply restore your device from the backup you made earlier. But I was just wondering if after this I would have to jailbreak my iPod again. So I bought myself an iPod Touch 4th Gen 32GB around Xmas purely for music and NO apps. But I've been recently thinking are there any useful tweaks I could use on my iPod Touch if I jailbroke? I'm currently running iOS 6.1.3 Stock. Themes I guess could be one but what exciting tweaks could I install? The iPod Touch 4th Gen/FaceTime as well as the iPod Touch 4th Gen 2011 and 2012 versions have a max update of iOS 6.1.6*. Otherwise, Here is an Instructables on a Jailbreak: Jailbreak iPod Touch 4th Gen. I do however not recommend jailbreaking your iPod Touch. Proceed at your own risk. Best of Luck! PLEASE READ!As you may know, jailbreaking an iPod is breaching apples security on the divide, therefore breaching any warrant. you should read up on jailbreaking before beginning this project.please do not report me for doing this tutorial, It is your choice to make if you want to jailbreak your iDevice.I DO NOT RECOMMEND JAILBREAKING YOUR IPHONE!This tutorial explains how to jailbreak an iPod running iOS 6.1.x(6.1, 2,3,4,6)ps. this is the untethered jailbreak.note: I did not come up with this way on my own, I used sites describing p0sixspwn.enjoy!The first thing you need is to make sure you have the right stuff.You will need...An iPod touch 4th generation running iOS 6.1.(0,1,2,3)-A computer to tether it to.(i used my macbook air)a charging USB cord to connect the iPod to the computer(standard apple cord)The ability to download softwareBEFORE YOU JAILBREAK.1-Read up on it. Make sure you know what your doing.2-Back up your iDevice through iTunes or iCloud.3-Make sure you are running the latest version of iTunes.4-If your device has a passcode lock, turn it off! you can put it back on when the jailbreaking is finished(after the end of this tutorial)NOW TO THE DOWNLOADINGYou will need to download two separate things, the application redsn0w and the firmware.step 1-download redsn0w. Go to (again, i did not find this link on my own) and click on version Redsn0w 0.9.15 beta 3. click on your computer type(windows, mac) and you will be brought to the download page. Download the file and wait. while you wait, you can download the firmware. Go to . Once on the site, go to the download IOS-jailbreak tab at the top left corner.Then scroll down to the get IOS.com widget.NOW PAY ATTENTIONThere are three categories you fill in. The iDevice, the model and the IOS version. fill in the first slot with whatever device you have. Fill the next slot with your iPod model(or iPad, or iPhone). The last slot is the one you won't expect. YOU MUST PUT IN IOS 6.0.0 NO MATTER WHAT IOS VERSION YOU ACTULY HAVE. When this is done, click the download button and wait.Once redsn0w and the firmware are downloaded, drag both to the desktop for easy access. Open the redsn0w folder and you will see five files and applications. Open the application redsn0w. Now plug your i device into your computer using your cable. DO NOT CLICK JAILBREAK YET!First click on extras. then go to select IPSW. IPSW is iPhone software. navigate to iPod4,1 6.0_10A403_Restore.ipsw (this is the firmware you just downloaded). it looks like a white lego block with a music note on one side and an iPod on the other. Click on it and a message will pop up. Click OK and go back to the main page and click jailbreak. Now since I already jailbroke my iPod I can't show you picture of a few steps, so I will do my best to describe them. You will need to select jailbreak options. MAKE SURE CYDIA IS SELECTED! you will eventually be told to put your device into DFU mode.(device firmware upgrade) To do this follow the instructions1-Hold the Power button on your iOS device down for 3 seconds.2- Now simultaneously hold the Home button and keep the two buttons pressed for 10 seconds. 3- Now release the Power button while keeping the Home button pressed until Redsn0w detects the device.your iDevice should reboot nowREMEMBER TO RELEASE THE HOME BUTTONyou will be notified when the process is complete, click OK then QUITWARNING: JAILBREAKING WILL TAKE SOME TIME. JUST WAIT AND BE PATIENT.while you are waiting, read up on teethed and unteathed jailbreaking. When the jailbreak is done, your device will reboot again. THIS MAY TAKE UP TO TEN MINNUTS. AGAIN, BE PATIENT!you will see your home screen, but cydia will not be on it. DO NOT PANIC. You now need to boot teethed jailbreak. You will switch to unteathed in a bit.to start off...launch redsn0w again on your computer and keep your iPod connected, go to extras, then to select IPSW. select iPod4,1 6.0_10A403_Restore.ipsw again, but this time go to just boot.Follow the onscreen instructions about turning your iPod off and the DFU.Your iDevice will reboot again, with a pineapple logo, indicating a teethed boot. WAIT AGAIN.When your iDevice turns back on, unlock it and look for the cydia logo. It looks like a brown and white box.If you can't find it, look for it in spotlight.YOUR NOT DONE YET!please go to a tutorial on cydia. I recommend Once you know the ropes, go to search. search p0sixspwn. click install at the top right(once it is installed, that tab will be switched to modify, like mine). your iPod will restart and when it comes back on, your done.Now that your iPod is jailbroken, here are some Cydia apps.look up how to install them online1-winterboard - to customize your iPod(note, you will need to download mods through winter board)2-AppCake- to get paid apps for free(NOTE: NOT LEAGAL)3-activator - for instant and easy flow on your iPodHave fun-Shadow513 Something went wrong. Wait a moment and try again. Due to hardware limitations the first generation iPad, iPhone 4 and iPod Touch 4th-gen did not get the iOS 7 update. This is because iOS 7 requires atleast 512MB of RAM but the iPod Touch 4G only has 256MB. Never-the-less, an untethered jailbreak has been released for the latest iOS version for all A4 devices. If you're on iOS 7 consider following this tutorial instead. How to jailbreak A4 devices (including iPod Touch 4G) on iOS 6.1.5 Before we start. This tutorial is compatible with iPad 1, iPod Touch 4th-gen and iPhone 4 on iOS 6.1.5. Follow this tutorial at your own risk and check local jailbreaking laws before proceeding. This method involves two steps by which we will first jailbreak our device into a tethered mode and then use a Cydia tweak to make it untethered. Step 1: You'll need to restore/update your device to iOS 6.1.5 via iTunes. Do this the usual way by connecting your device to iTunes using the USB cable and click the Restore or Update button. You must do this through iTunes and not OTA or you may encounter errors. Step 2: Download the iOS 6.0 IPSW file from here. And the latest version of Redsn0w from here. Step 3: Now your iDevice has been restored to a fresh copy of iOS 6.1.5 you need to launch the Redsn0w application to get started with the jailbreak process. Step 4: Once you have launched Redsn0w click Extra and then choose Select IPSW and browse for the IPSW file you downloaded in Step 2. Once you have done that, click Back and then click Jailbreak. Step 5: You will now be prompted to follow the onscreen instructions to put your device into DFU mode to allow the software to implement the exploit. Just follow the steps onscreen. Your device will now reboot several times, and once the process is complete you will need to boot into a tethered jailbroken state. Step 6: Now head back to Extra and click Select IPSW and choose the IPSW file you downloaded in Step 2. Then click the first option Just Boot. Similarly to Step 5 you will need to put your device into DFU mode again, but this time when the process completes you should see Cydia on your springboard. Step 7: Your device is currently in a tethered jailbreak condition. To remove this condition we are going to use a Cydia tweak... Steo 8: Launch Cydia from your springboard and follow all the steps to set it up for the first time. Then head over to the Manage tab and add the source: Step 9: Once all the packages from the new repo are updated, touch onto Return to Cydia and then head over to the Search tab and search for p0sixspwn. (Thats pee-zero-ess-eye-eks-ess-pee-double you-en). Step 10: Install the package as in the image below and voila! Untethered iOS 6.1.5 jailbreak! And finally, as requested - here is a video tutorial on jailbreaking the iPod Touch 4th-gen on iOS 6.1.5. If you're on iOS 7.0.4 you can use this tutorial to jailbreak. Update 25/12/13: If you can't load the iH8sn0w repo try: 1. Go to Manage > Sources 2. Tap onto the Cydia Repo 3. Scroll to P 4. You should see p0sixspwn 5. Install it
