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Required Time: 15 minutes **Event Details:** The Ready Player Two event was held across multiple Roblox games, including Dungeon Quest, where players could earn rewards like the Chaotic Top Hat avatar item by completing two steps. **Step 1: Finding Gems[]** - **Step 1.1:** Collecting Gems in Order[] Players must collect gems in a specific sequence (red, yellow, blue, cyan, white, purple, green) located throughout Lobby 1. **Locations:** **Red Gem:** Follow the path past training dummies and find it near a tree after turning right. **Yellow Gem:** Go back across the bridge, up the hill behind the sell merchant, and along the large wall until reaching an orange tree. **Blue Gem:** Continue following the wall towards the orange tree, then take a left to find the blue gem on another tree with leaves. **Cyan Gem:** Head back into town, swim through an underwater tunnel near the bridge (right of where you found the red gem), and enter the tunnel facing that direction. **White Gem:** Immediately turn right after passing training dummies and logs, and head up the hill to find it under a wooden overhang. **Purple Gem:** Go towards the dock, then face the large door with a broken crystal; it's over a small hill immediately to the right. **Green Gem:** Return to spawn and find a blue house with a path leading underneath. Enter this opening to access an obby. **Step 2: Accessing the Glitch Dungeon[]** - **Step 1.2: Entering Code Door[]** After collecting gems correctly, go to the cave near the sell merchant for a keypad with a hidden code behind bars. Alternatively: 5 lanterns around the map will flash on and off after collecting all gems; the number of lit lamps indicates each digit (e.g., 3 lamps light up means the digit is 3). Formulate a 6-digit code from these numbers. **Glitch Dungeon[]** Accessing the Glitch dungeon requires no level requirement, but it must be played solo. The dungeon can be accessed after completing the steps above and has a time limit of 15 minutes. To conquer the dungeon, a timer starts counting down once you leave the spawn room. The soundtrack features Questing and Boss themes. When leaving the spawn room, the questing theme begins, while the boss theme starts when breaking the second energy barrier. Gameplay is pre-set upon entering the Glitch dungeon. The Q slot ability is Phase Barrage, firing three energy waves dealing 25 damage each with a 6-second cooldown. E slot is Chain Phase Shock, creating an orb that explodes after 1 second, dealing 65 damage to nearby enemies with a 4-second cooldown. You can deal melee damage and activate Phase Barrage during Chain Phase Shock, but not vice versa. Your total health is 150, armor provides 50, and you have three lives, which can only be lost while fighting The Glitch boss. Rooms include: The Two-Energy Source Boss The boss in this dungeon has two energy sources with 300 HP each that provide a shield from all attacks. It also heals itself passively by 30 HP every 7 seconds when both sources are active. The Auto Attack feature is triggered only when the energy sources are active, and its cycle will reset to Phase 1 after they're destroyed. Upon defeating the boss, the room's lighting changes from red to cyan. Note that this dungeon does not grant any in-game rewards, but players receive the Meet the Developer! badge upon their first defeat. Completing the dungeon also grants the Chaotic Top Hat accessory on Roblox. Trivia This dungeon was featured in an official Roblox event for the second time, with the previous one being the Egg Hunt 2020: Agents of E.G.G. event. If players have already obtained the badge, they can still access the code door upon rejoining the lobby without repeating the process. However, the devs' backend update on August 8, 2023, affected some players who had previously obtained the badge. The Chaotic Top Hat is an accessory published in November 2020 and has been obtained over 424,558 times since January 28, 2021. Don't turn right up the path; instead, look behind one of the first trees you find, where you'll discover a red gem. The yellow gem is located behind a long stone building with a crack in the wall, which can be accessed by traveling upward from the spawn point. For the blue gem, follow the path from the yellow gem's location and look behind a tree to find it. The Cyan gem is situated under the wooden bridge, accessible by swimming below the bridge and entering an underwater cave. To find the white gem, search behind trees near the Advanced Training Bags. The purple gem can be found just past the large closed door in the mountain, located behind a rock wall to the right of the door. Finally, the green gem is hidden behind the spawn point where boulders block a cave; climb the boulders and enter the cave to find it. To obtain the 6-digit code for Step 2, count the blinking lights above the Boulder cave until you see all five lights at once. Remember that each player's code is unique. To verify your code, use recording software like OBS or carefully watch the sequence until you're confident in your selection. Once you have the correct code, enter it on the keypad to access Step 3. This sequence has a 10-minute timer, so proceed quickly. Break down the door to enter an obby, time your jumps correctly, and safely reach the other side. In the final chamber, face The Glitch Boss: when the ground changes grey, quickly run behind a server to avoid damage. Avoid red and grey lines while spamming Q and E attacks to minimize damage from lasers. A powerful combo attack can significantly damage the Glitch's health. When its health drops to halfway, two stationary power machines will emerge, capable of slowly healing the Glitch. You must swiftly eliminate these machines to prevent them from reviving the enemy. If you lose a life, your progress remains intact, but be cautious not to exhaust all three lives. Once you defeat the Glitch, it disappears, and you'll earn a Mission Completed badge along with the Chaotic Top Hat as a reward.
