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# Worksheet for irregular verbs in past tense

Weekly newsletter The irregular verbs are verbs that do not follow the agreement to add "and" at the end of the Word to form past declarations. Although there are only about 180 thesis verbs spent in modern English language, they are the most commonly acting verbs. According to Steven Pinker, 70% of the time we use a verb, it is an irregular verb. The implication for pedagogy is that irregular verbs are an extremely important area to be covered.
